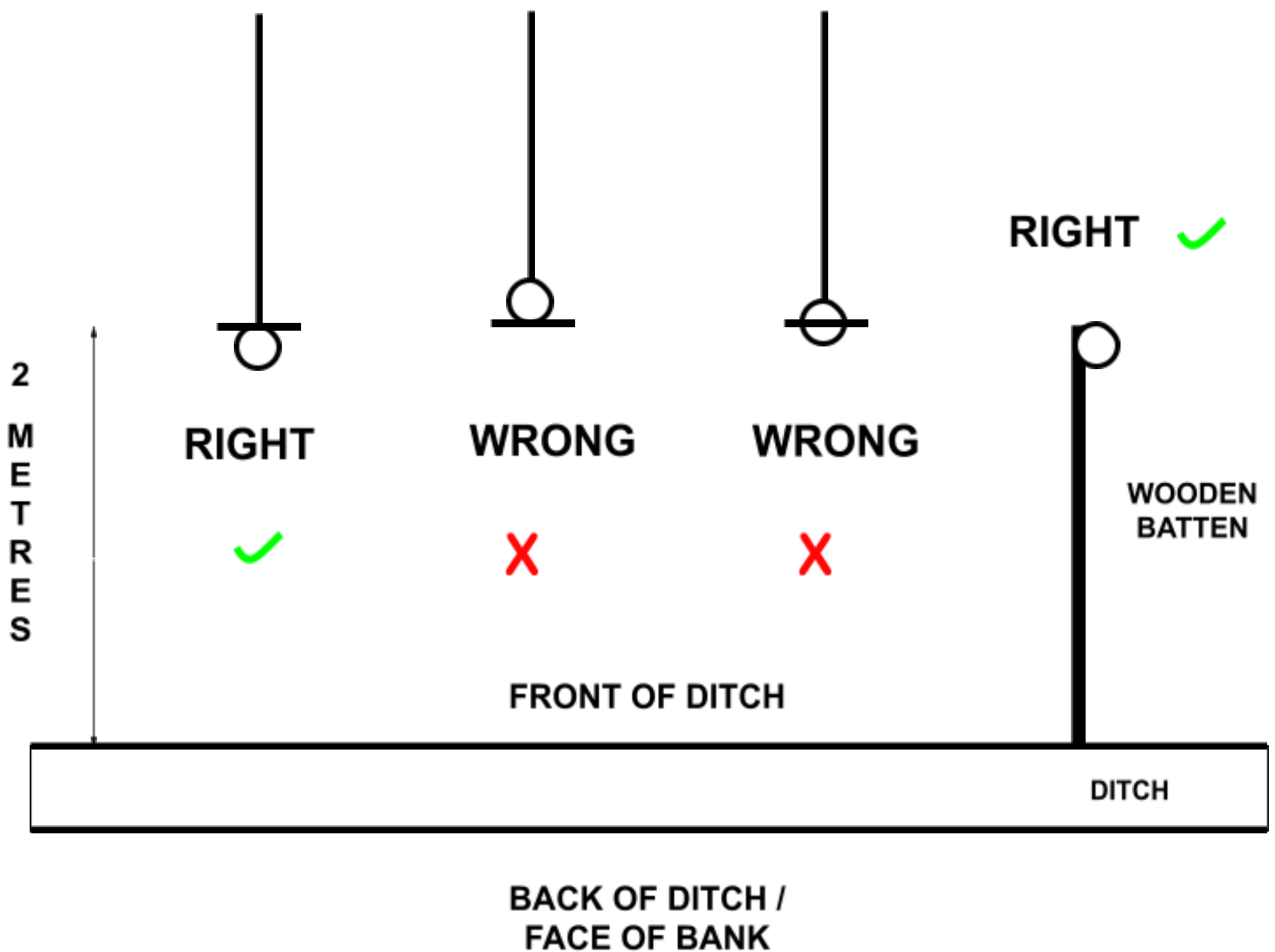


CORRECT PLACEMENT OF JACK AT THE 2 METRE MARK



9.2 If the jack in its original course comes to rest less than 2 metres from the front ditch, it must be placed on the centre line of the rink with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line being 2 metres from the front ditch. This must be done by: 9.2.1 placing the jack at a mark on the centre line of the rink measuring a distance of 2 metres from the front ditch (see diagram B.3.1 in appendix B.3); or 9.2.2 placing the jack alongside the edge of a 2-metre measuring device (for example, a thin wooden batten which is 2 metres long - see diagram B.3.2 in appendix B.3)
